

CENSUS RECORDS—1871 TO 1911

The census records for the period between 1871 and 1911 are useful historical documents. Because communities and families are both recorded, it is possible to trace movement through this period and for students to have an understanding of communities throughout Nova Scotia prior to Centralization.
